Work Underway on £2.5m Regeneration Scheme Delivering New Homes in Dawley

A £2.5m regeneration project led by Housing Plus Group, in partnership with developer R1 Construction, is set to transform a small estate in Telford with the delivery of 16 high-quality, energy-efficient bungalows for social rent. The scheme will replace five outdated bungalows at The Ley in Dawley that are no longer fit for purpose due to significant structural issues.

Designed with affordability, sustainability, and community well-being at its core, the new development includes a mix of 10 one-bedroom and 6 two-bedroom bungalows. The project has been carefully planned to meet a range of housing needs, and one of the properties will be purpose-built for a local family with specialist accessibility requirements.

The regeneration of The Ley reflects Housing Plus Group's long-term vision to provide homes that are not only affordable but also built to modern standards of energy efficiency and comfort. The new homes will be constructed using innovative building methods that support the group's ambitions for more sustainable development and reduced carbon impact.

Wayne Gethings, Group Chief Executive of Housing Plus Group, said: "This regeneration project at The Ley represents much more than replacing ageing properties. It's about creating a place people are proud to call home. Our commitment to delivering high-quality, energy efficient homes is matched by our ambition to create a thriving and sustainable community This development will contribute to our ambition to deliver nearly 1,000 homes each year."

The development is being delivered in collaboration with The Wrekin Housing Group, whose ongoing investment in the area supports the creation of strong, resilient neighbourhoods.

Martin James, Development and Regeneration Manager with Housing Plus Group said: "The Ley is a scheme which has been long in the making and is another excellent example of partners coming together to create positive outcomes for local people. We're proud to be working alongside R1 Construction to deliver high-quality homes that respond directly to the need for affordable, energy-efficient housing in our communities. This development will make a real difference by providing much-needed homes where they are needed most."

We're on site beginning works at Wigston Block B!





Following approval from the Planning Authority and the Department for Education (DfE), works are now underway on site at Wigston College in Leicestershire. R1 Construction has commenced a soft strip out of the existing Block B, with demolition scheduled to begin shortly.

The project will see the replacement of the disused two-storey building, which has stood vacant for a decade due to major structural defects, with a modern, purpose-built single-storey facility. The new building will provide six classrooms, group rooms, an ICT suite, and ancillary spaces, creating an enhanced learning environment for students.

The £2.26 million project is funded through a successful Condition Improvement Fund (CIF) bid following detailed condition surveys, structural investigations, and feasibility studies that demonstrated the need for a full replacement.





Telford College Revisit Webb Crescent



Between November 2024 and March 2025, 18 students from Telford College took part in a structured industry placement programme, each spending two full days on site. The initiative provided valuable first-hand experience and practical insights into the construction process, allowing students to apply their classroom learning in a live project environment. New Projects at Albrighton Primary School & Stourport High School

We're pleased to share updates on two exciting education projects now underway for the new academic year.

At The Stourport High School & VIth Form College in Stourport-on-Severn, we're working with Sheppard Building & Project Consultancy to refurbish the middle block, library, and reception /officeareas. The works include internal strip-out, reconfiguration, M&E upgrades, and full fit-out to enhance the layout, functionality, and overall environment for staff and students. Completion is planned ahead of September.

Meanwhile, at Albrighton School, we're delivering a transformative scheme for Property Services Group (PSG). This includes major internal alterations to create purpose-built SEND support spaces and a complete reconfiguration of nursery facilities. From September, the school will welcome 7–8 children with SEND needs, growing to 16 places, supported by specialist teaching environments. Works also include a new toddlers' classroom, reorganisation of existing spaces, and new toilet facilities.

Both projects reflect our commitment to creating high-quality, functional, and inspiring learning environments, and we look forward to sharing progress over the summer.

Dawley High Street Progress!


We're pleased to be on site and making excellent progress at our project on Dawley High Street.

Works began with the safe removal of asbestos, carried out in full compliance with current regulations, followed by the controlled demolition of the former council offices. Once the site was cleared, groundworks commenced, including the removal of an existing cellar, which records show was once a meat store for the building's original occupiers, before installing the new foundations.

The foundations were then prepared with Spantherm insulated flooring units, a gas membrane for protection against ground gases, and a screed layer.

A crane was on site for five days to complete the installation of the SIPs, and we're now progressing well towards achieving first fix on the apartments.

Brickwork has now been completed in readiness for the installation of structural insulated panels later this month.
